Percon Construction Inc. is a full service contractor/builder with the capability, knowledge and expertise to take on mid to large-size industrial, commercial, and institutional projects.

THE CHALLENGE

Like many companies, Percon Construction's Occupational Health and Safety clerical tasks used to be completed manually, by a team that would have much rather spent the excessive administration hours in the field, communicating directly with company personnel.
